Keiser wins approval for doctoral programs

Keiser University has received approval from the **Southern Association of Colleges and Schools** as a Level V institution and will offer the doctor of philosophy in educational leadership program.

The program will be offered fully online. The degree is designed for scholars and professions to improve the educational institutions they lead, a release said.

Areas of study include curriculum design, management of distance education, funding of educational institutions, and politics and community relations.

Based in Fort Lauderdale, Keiser has about 15,000 students attending its 13 Florida campuses, which include locations in Orlando, Melbourne and Daytona Beach. Keiser began offering bachelor degrees in 2003 and master's programs in 2006.
